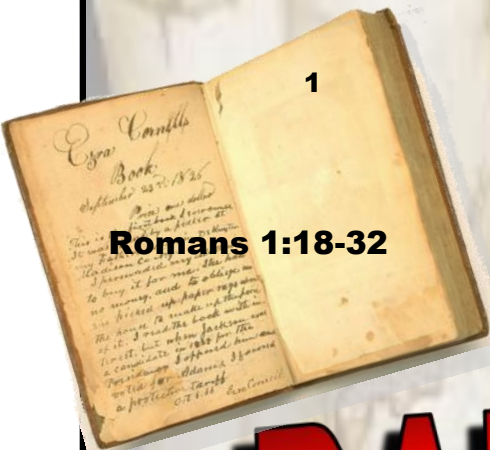
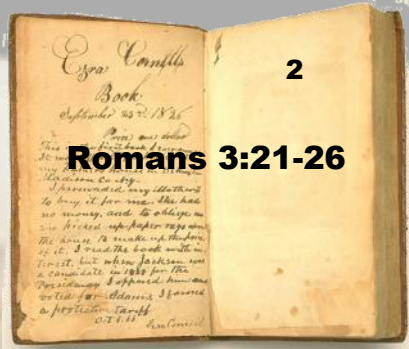

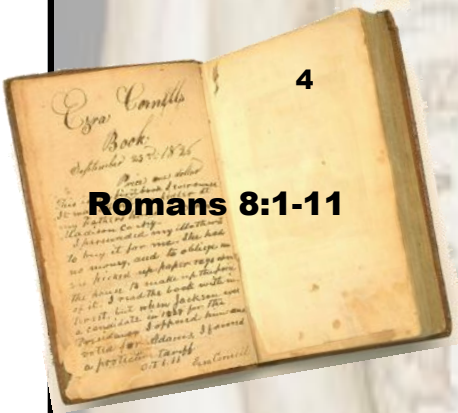

While you may not have known it, my family comes from Ireland, as well as England. In fact, I come from an Irish clan known as the Daeseey (day see) clan. The Daeseies still had a castle, as well as quite a bit of property over in Ireland. A few years ago I had the privilege of looking up my clan's history and learning more about my Irish roots. There is even a whole town in England named Crawley, England! For what it's worth, "top o the mornin to ya" is rarely used among the Irish," but it means something like "Good day."

Unfortunately after Grandma Daeseey passed on to be with Lord and her husband, Pa Pa Brown left this earth, the castle had to be sold and with it the last of the Daeseey property. A new life had to be started and the old things passed away with time. This is a spiritual truth for believers. Our old lives before Christ have died and we have been born again. We mustn't allow the sin that has been conquered to rule and reign in our lives. We have been given new life in Christ. Listen to what Paul says in Romans 6:

*What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? <sup>2</sup> By no means! We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? <sup>3</sup> Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup> We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (NIV version)*

While I openly confess that my Irish heritage is something I am proud of and do not consider sinful by any stretch of the imagination, I simply use this illustration to make a point. My family started a new life in America and over time they lost their ties with their former country. The Daesies became the Martins and through the Martins, the Crawleys became connected with the Daesies. Now here I am. I have received new life through the blood and power of Jesus Christ. My old life as a sinner has passed away. I cannot continue to live a life of sin because now I am a Christian. Embrace your new life in Christ and the leave the old things behind.

I hope you enjoyed this Word from the Lord in His book of Romans. This month we will starting a series on Romans titled: Raiders of the Lost Book. We will be digging deep into the thickness of spiritual truth contained in this wonderful book of Scripture. I pray you will join us and grow in the Lord.

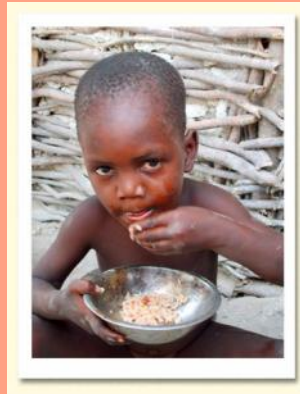
- On the 30th, all AWANA clubs will be working on Spring projects for the residents of Statesville Manor.
